Depending on his or her expertise and training, the successful candidate will join the Department of Physiology and Pharmacology or the Department of Anatomy and Cellular Biology in the Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences.

Moreover, he or she shall demonstrate an aptitude for teaching as well as for attracting, supervising, and guiding graduate students and postdoctoral fellows in the Faculty's various programs.

- Be able to conduct research projects independently.
- Demonstrate aptitudes for working within disciplinary and interdisciplinary teams.
