VISITING PROFESSORSHIPS OR POSDOCTORAL POSITIONS  
CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

The National Institute of Medical Sciences and Nutrition (INCMNSZ) in Mexico and the National Autonomous University of Mexico (UNAM) are inviting active researchers or postdoctoral students that wish to spend one or two years in a stimulating scientific environment within the INCMNSZ to pursue collaborative work with a specific research group.

The INCMNSZ is a prestigious biomedical research institution located in Mexico City. Its main research fields are those related to internal medicine and its specialties, high level surgery and transplants, genomic medicine, basic, clinical and population nutrition, as well as reproductive biology. The offer includes a year stipend of 48,000 USD, economy travel expenses, 12,000 USD for the project expenses and lodging at the Institute's professor facilities.

Availability to undertake the program beginning on the first trimester of 2015.

The eligibility criteria for applicants are:

1. Graduate biomedical researchers holding a PhD degree or a physician with a clearly defined clinical research track.
2. Fluent in English or Spanish.
3. Maximum age 65 years old.
4. Good general health status.
5. The research field ought to be of common interest to the Institute's based researchers.
6. It is required that the applicant develops, in advance, his/her activity plan for the whole year in a joint way with the identified institutional research group. The proposed research plan needs to be signed by both the applicant as well as the co-investigator from the Institute
