



Postdoctoral opportunity on a large-scale project involving decision-makers, clinicians, patients and caregivers

We are looking for a postdoctoral fellow to work on an interprovincial project on the trajectories of seniors in Quebec and Ontario led by Doctors Amélie Quesnel-Vallée and Isabelle Vedel of McGill University.

The postdoctoral fellow will conduct a qualitative study that aims to select, contextualize and prioritize relevant health indicators for seniors with stakeholders (decision-makers, clinicians, patients and caregivers) and analyze the factors influencing seniors' care trajectories. This project is funded by the Canadian Institutes for Health Research (CIHR) and will last 1 to 3 years (depending on the wish of the postdoctoral fellow).

The postdoctoral fellow will have the opportunity to work with two world-class research teams; the **R**esearch on **O**rganization of healthcare **S**ervices for **A**lzheimer's (ROSA) team and the McGill Observatory on Health and Social Services Reforms (MOHSSR). This project is funded by the CIHR.

- Experience in stakeholder engagement is an asset
